
And for non-urdu students, the school teaches the importance of Moral Values.



Instructions:

- 1. Application forms to be filled in completely and submitted at office along with:
- (A) Copy of Transfer certificate from the school last attended/birth certificate for Pre-primary.
- (B) Four recent passport size photograph.
- (C) Photocopy of marks sheet of previous class.
- (D) The originals to be produced at the time of admission.
- 2. A written entrance test will be conducted and admission will be totally on merit. Whereas for the kindergarten interview will be taken.
- 3. The academic year consists of three terms i.e.

Term I: June - September Term II: October - January Term III: February - May

4. Books will be supplied at the school store.



- 5. Fees: Fee to be paid on or before the 10th of every month. The fee for month of May can be paid along with Jan/Feb fee. Late fee will be applicable for fee paid late.
- 6. The caution deposit from classes I to X is mandatory and it is refundable without interest; if there is no damage to the school's infrastructure by your child, on completion of his/her study in school and after passing class X.
- 7. School Timings: 8:00 am to 2:30 pm. Study hour will be conducted after 2:30 pm. Students must be present 10 minutes before the Assembly starts.
- 8. Parents have to collect their children immediately after the school hours and there is no responsibility of the school.
- 9. Please note that a minimum of 80% attendance is must for promotion into next class.
- 10. Students should come to school in complete school uniform from Monday to Friday. And on Saturday's, students have to wear their group T-shirts and skirts (for girls), Trousers (for boys).
- 11. When a student has to leave early, the parents should take prior permission from the H.M.
- 12. The evaluation of the students by the school authority will be final for admission, promotion or detention.
- 13. All students shall abide by the rules and regulations laid down by the school at all times.
